## HOW TO USE THE RUFFLER.

Remove the regular foot, and slip the ruler in its place with the forks of the lever A over the shank of the needle set screm ald fasten securely. Place the goods to be ruffed between the steel blades F . To mas scant ruffing, raise the adjusting block C
 by-tirr, rg the thumberew $B$, and shorten the stitch to the desired length. 'The iength of stitch shonld n/atch the size of gather or plait, so that they will lie even and not pile up on each other or be too far apark To make larger plaits, lower the block $C$ and lengthen the stitch to match. If the ruffle is to be attsched to a band, place the band below both blades.
For shifring or ruflling more than one inch from the edge of wide goods, slightly loosen the ${ }_{\llcorner }$screw D from the right hand side of the ruffler when on the machine and remove the part with the under hade F attached. Now remove the front shut for race slide of theronine ${ }^{2}{ }^{1}$ slipthe shirriner side (it in its place, pushing it in as far as it will go, nd faston with the screw 1). Led ar
 vithout one of them. Never run the machipe when tho ruffler is on without goods between the steel blades, because the movem int of the teeth of the upper blade against the lower will dull them and soon make it up

## HOW TO USE THE TUCKER.

The Tucker attaches the same as the ruffler. Loosen the adjusting screw K and move the gauge $L$ to the desired width of tuck, af shown by scale M. For example set it at the figure 1; now move the marker until ty pointer O is over figure 1 on its scale also. The tucks will then be one-eighth of an ing wide and jast rituer. Fch space lutiveen the tucks, move the marker to the left as mich as the space desired.


THE HEMMERS-4 widths. Attach hemmer to attachment holder as above, find pass the goods into the scroll, being careful to draw it through the hemmer ias far as the needle hole that the feed may catch the cloth. Should too much goods run into the hemmer. carry to left.

THE BINDER-Attach binder to holder as above. If cutbinding is used inould be bias and seven eighths of an inch wide. Pjuss through binder and place goods between upper and lower scrolls.
